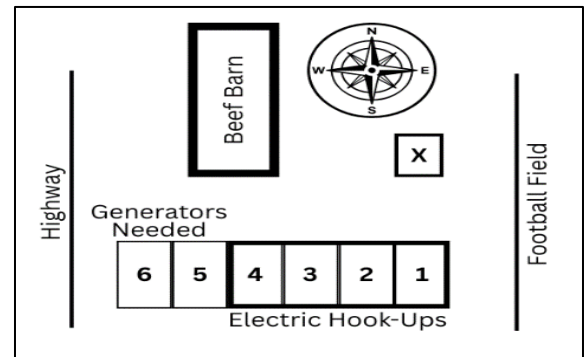

Overnight Camping General Information



Staying Overnight at the Edwards County Fairgrounds:

Camp Site Reservation General Rules:

1. No campsite reservations for the Edwards County Fair will be accepted until after April 1st of the current Fair Year.
2. Camp sites will be assigned by number and selected on the day the reservation is received and paid for at the Extension Office. Otherwise, "1st Come, 1st to Choose" will be adhered to, with the exception of certain circumstances decreed by the Edwards County Fair Board.
3. During setup for the Edwards County Fair, no camper shall be permitted on the Edwards County Fairgrounds until the Sunday before the Edwards County Fair and no earlier than 8:00 am. For earlier setup, see the Edwards County Fair Board for special permission.

Liability Release:

The Edwards County Fair Board, Edwards County, City of Kinsley, 21 Central Extension District, Edwards County 4-H Council, Kansas State 4-H Youth & Development, or Kansas State Extension are NOT liable for loss or damage of any personal property while on the Edwards County Fairgrounds. In no case shall any of the mentioned parties or any of their officers be held responsible for damages, loss, injury, death, or disability by disease, or from the theft or from any other cause to any such property or person at the Edwards County Fairgrounds. The Edwards County Fair Board hereby refuses to assume any responsibility for the safety as bailee or otherwise, or any property brought upon the Edwards County Fairgrounds, said property being brought upon and kept upon said grounds at the owner's risk.

The Edwards County Fair Board reserves the right to construct its own rules and regulations, as well as determine all matters or deference, in regard thereto.

The Edwards County Fair Board reserves the right to remove from the Edwards County Fairgrounds any person(s), exhibit, animal, concession, or show that may be falsely entered or which in any manner may be deemed objectionable or harmful to the public at large. Any unnecessary horseplay on the Edwards County Fairgrounds will result in the forfeiture of all premium money or loss of deposit.

Overnight Stay – Permission Form



Only Edwards County 4-H members, siblings, parents, leaders, and alumni have expressed permission to stay overnight at the Edwards County Fairgrounds.

4-Hers who plan to stay overnight during the Edwards County Fair, to care for their livestock, are responsible for having this form completed and turned into the Extension – 4-H Office by 8:00 pm on Tuesday (the week of the Fair). **ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS!**

All 4-Hers must have a 4-H adult chaperone stay with them, who will be responsible for their safety and behavior. One parent will be responsible for NO more than seven (7) 4-Hers. A sibling over 18 may sign up to stay only with his/her siblings. All 4-Hers and youth without permission to stay must leave the Edwards County Fairgrounds by 11:00 pm.

The Edwards County Fair Board and 21 Central Extension District staff will NOT be responsible for supervising youth staying overnight.

KANSAS 4-H CODE OF CONDUCT

As a participant in the Kansas 4-H program, you have the responsibility of representing Kansas 4-H to the public. You are expected to conduct yourself in a manner that will bring honor to you, your family, and 4-H. To do that, you must:

1. Conduct yourself and your project work in a manner that is trustworthy, respectful, responsible, fair, caring, and in good citizenship.
2. Be responsible for your actions by following the rules and being accountable. This includes being in assigned program locations/sessions, abiding by deadlines, times, and housing arrangements. If you are unable to participate or need assistance, notify the event/program organizers.
3. Treat yourself, other people, animals, and property with respect, using good manners, dressing appropriately, and by not using profanity. You will be personally responsible for any damage caused as a result of your behavior. Know that the use of tobacco, alcohol, and non-prescribed drugs by youth is illegal.
4. Demonstrate caring for people other than yourself. Know that harassment of any type is illegal and prohibited at all 4-H events.
5. Be a good citizen by participating fully and helping those around you have positive experiences.
